

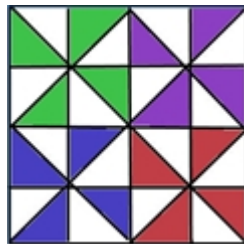
# Piecing Partners Quilt Guild

## Block of the Month

### July 2010

#### Country Pinwheel

9.5 inch unfinished



You will need for each **9.5 inch unfinished square**, scraps of red, brown, black, green and white/cream coloured fabrics (prints/tone on tone/solids/marbles, etc. You should use the fabrics you have been using this season)

Make a 9-inch square quilt block using scraps of green, black, brown, red and cream/white cotton fabrics. Solids or prints can be mixed and matched.

Cut two each 3 1/8 inch squares from the green, black, brown and red fabrics that you have been using all this season for the BOM.

Cut eight each 3 1/8 inch squares from the cream/white fabric.

Using your favourite method to make 1/2 square triangles, make a 1/2 square triangle from each coloured square and a cream/white square.

All seams should be pressed toward the darker fabric.

Make 4 pinwheels by sewing the four squares of each color together as shown in the diagram. Then sew each of the four larger squares together as illustrated to make the 9.5 inch unfinished pinwheel block pattern.

**Remember**, if you make one extra block of the month to keep for yourself you will have a nine block sampler top of all the blocks of the month for 2010 by October.
