### IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT EXHIBITOR PROTECT THE ITEM AGAINST LOSS OR DAMAGE THROUGH HOUSEHOLD OR OTHER INSURANCE

I understand that reasonable care will be taken of the item from the time it is dropped off at Sunnyside Christian Church until it is picked up.

Nevertheless, the Guild cannot accept financial responsibility for anything that may happen to the property of the exhibitor.

By signing this statement as part of the entry form, I expressly agree to release the "Pikes Peak Quilt Show" Committee, Piecing Partners Quilt Guild, and their respective agents, members from all liability for any loss, damage, theft, injury or destruction to the item entered by me in the Pikes Peak Quilt Show in Colorado Springs, Colorado. I understand and assume that I bear the risk of all uninsured loss to my own property and that it is up to me to properly insure my own property against any or all risks if I so choose.

I hereby give permission to the Guild to have the item photographed, and for the Guild to use the photographs, likeness or any other representation of the item as they see fit, in the Guild newsletter, or for future advertising and/or profit-making purposes.

## Pikes Peak Quilt Show Entry Guidelines and Procedures

### GENERAL INFORMATION

Please read the following Guidelines and Procedures carefully.

Only members of Piecing Partners Quilt Guild may enter an item in the show.

Each member may enter at least 1 item. If you wish to enter additional items, complete a separate entry form for each item. Please indicate your order of priority, in case there are space limitations and not all items can be displayed. There is no entry fee.

### ENTRY GUIDELINES

- The item must be finished and in good condition. It should be neat, clean, and "show ready" with no visible markings, tears, loose threads, bearding, soil, pet hair, or stains. Quilts will be inspected upon receipt, the condition of the item noted by a Quilt Show Committee (QSC) member and initialed by the exhibitor.
- Please chose **ONE** of the following categories that **primarily** fits your item and circle the category on the Entry Form under Category.
  - Pieced Traditional: Quilts with a recognizable traditional pattern.
  - Pieced Innovative: Quilts with original, non-traditional design.
  - Appliqué: traditional or innovative
  - Embroidery: Either hand or machine
  - Whole cloth: Either machine or hand quilted
  - Crazy Quilt
  - Pictorial: The idea or concept being represented must be recognizable to the viewer (such as landscape or portrait)
  - Art: May use mixed media, unusual materials or techniques such as paper, paint or found items
  - Miniature Quilts: Must not exceed 24"x24" or a total of 96" around all outside edges. Any style or technique is permitted. If composed of blocks, they must not exceed 4"
  - Wearable Art: Garment, jacket
  - Dolls
- Sleeves are not necessary for the quilt hanging system used by PPQS.
- Wearable art must have a drape to hide the hanging system. To make a drape, chose a color that best complements the garment. Divide one yard of fabric into thirds and sew the ends together to form a drape approximately 15" wide and 100" long. This will cover the hanging system.  
A label must be sewn to the back of each quilt and attached securely to items other than quilts. The following information will be required on the label. Items without a label will not be accepted.
  - Maker(s) name
  - Title
  - Date completed
  - Quilted by
- A number will be assigned and pinned to the item before it is displayed. This number will correspond to the number of the Exhibitor and PPQS Receipts.
- A card with the Artist's Statement (see Entry Form) will also be pinned to the front of the quilt and attached to other items in the most suitable way possible. This is a statement of why it was made, inspirations, special techniques used, patterns used, awards won, other shows displayed at or design elements. This is your chance to speak to the viewers.
- A completed Entry Form with attached photo, signed original of Insurance Waiver, Assumption of Risk and Photography Release & Appraisal (if applicable) must be turned in to the Quilt Show Intake Committee table at a General Membership meeting.
- No entries will be accepted after **September 16<sup>th</sup> General Membership Meeting. NO EXCEPTIONS.** Since this is our first show, time is needed to plan the layout of the show from the information obtained from the entry forms. Please be realistic about what you can finish to avoid withdrawals.

### DROP OFF & PICK UP

- **No entries may be dropped off prior to Thursday, October 15<sup>th</sup> at 2:30.** In order to avoid long waiting periods the Quilt Show Intake Committee will assign a time slot for you to bring your item(s) as well as a pick up time at the end of the show.
- No entries may be removed during the show nor will you be allowed to take your items down at the end of the show. Due to liability and security issues, your **CLAIM RECEIPT WILL BE REQUIRED** for quilt pick up either by you or your designee. If you have designated someone other than yourself to pick up your item we will also ask for photo identification from that person.
- We must be completely out of the church by 6:00pm on Saturday, October 17<sup>th</sup>. All items must be picked up prior to 6:00.
